Child and Adult Care Food Program

Have you ever considered participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)? You're probably thinking... it's not worth it. Food for thought, you never lose money when on CACFP!!

CACFP is a federally funded program designed to improve the nutritional quality of meals served to children in childcare centers and childcare homes.

On CACFP you must keep daily records including your child attendance, your menus and your meal counts. The amount of reimbursement you receive is based on the location of your home, your income or the income of the parents you serve. Your own children may be eligible to participate if you meet the income guideline. All information is kept confidential.
