How to Register with ECETP



1. Go to <https://www.ecetp.pdp.albany.edu> and sign up for an account. You'll need an email address, your Facility ID # and expiration date to create a username and password.
2. Once your account is created, go to <https://www.ecetp.pdp.albany.edu/findtraining.aspx> and search for either MAT or Health & Safety. Then choose your preferred date and click "Apply for this Training."
3. After signing up with ECETP, you must contact us at (315) 446-1220 to pay your course fee.

Certification Courses The following certification courses are held at our Syracuse Office located at 6724 Thompson Road.

Adult & Pediatric CPR/First Aid: This course incorporates the latest science and teaches students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid emergencies such as burns, cuts, scrapes, sudden illnesses, head, neck, back injuries, heat/cold emergencies and how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age - adults (about 12 years and older) and pediatric (infants and children up to 12 years of age). Students who successfully complete this **one-day course** will receive a certificate for the American Red Cross Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED valid for two years.

Health & Safety Training: Competencies for Becoming a Family or Group Family Day Care Provider: This competency-based course provides a foundation for practices that promote and protect the health and safety of children in home-based child care. Successful completion of this course is required for all new family or group family day care applicants in New York State prior to licensure or registration, as well as for existing family or group family day care providers who change location or modality.

This course is divided into three sessions; **must attend all three to earn your certificate.** Saturday sessions are held from **8:00 AM - 4:00 PM**, Wednesday sessions are held from **5:30 PM - 9:00 PM**.

Medication Administration Training (MAT): This competency-based course provides specific instruction on safely administering over the counter and prescription medication to children in child care programs. Successful completion of this course is required for an individual to administer medication in a child day care program. This is the only course approved by OCFS for this purpose. **MAT: Classroom Skills Competencies** is designed for the student who prefers the structure of a classroom setting, and is split into two full day sessions. You must attend both sessions to earn your certificate.
